**Last year in Late Winter:** 2005 - Present

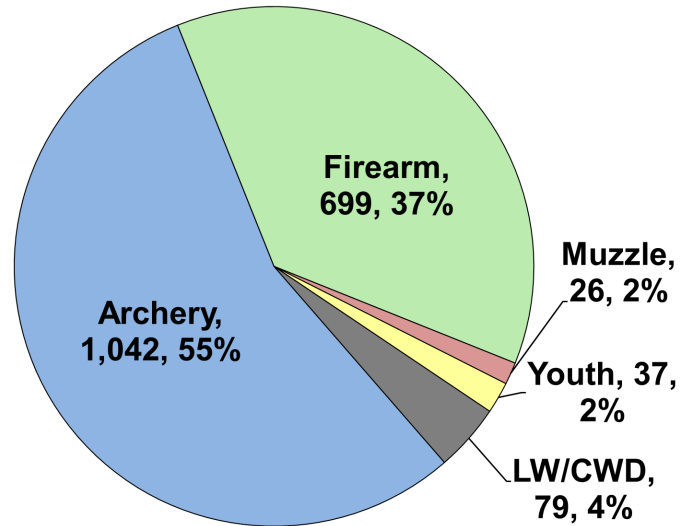
